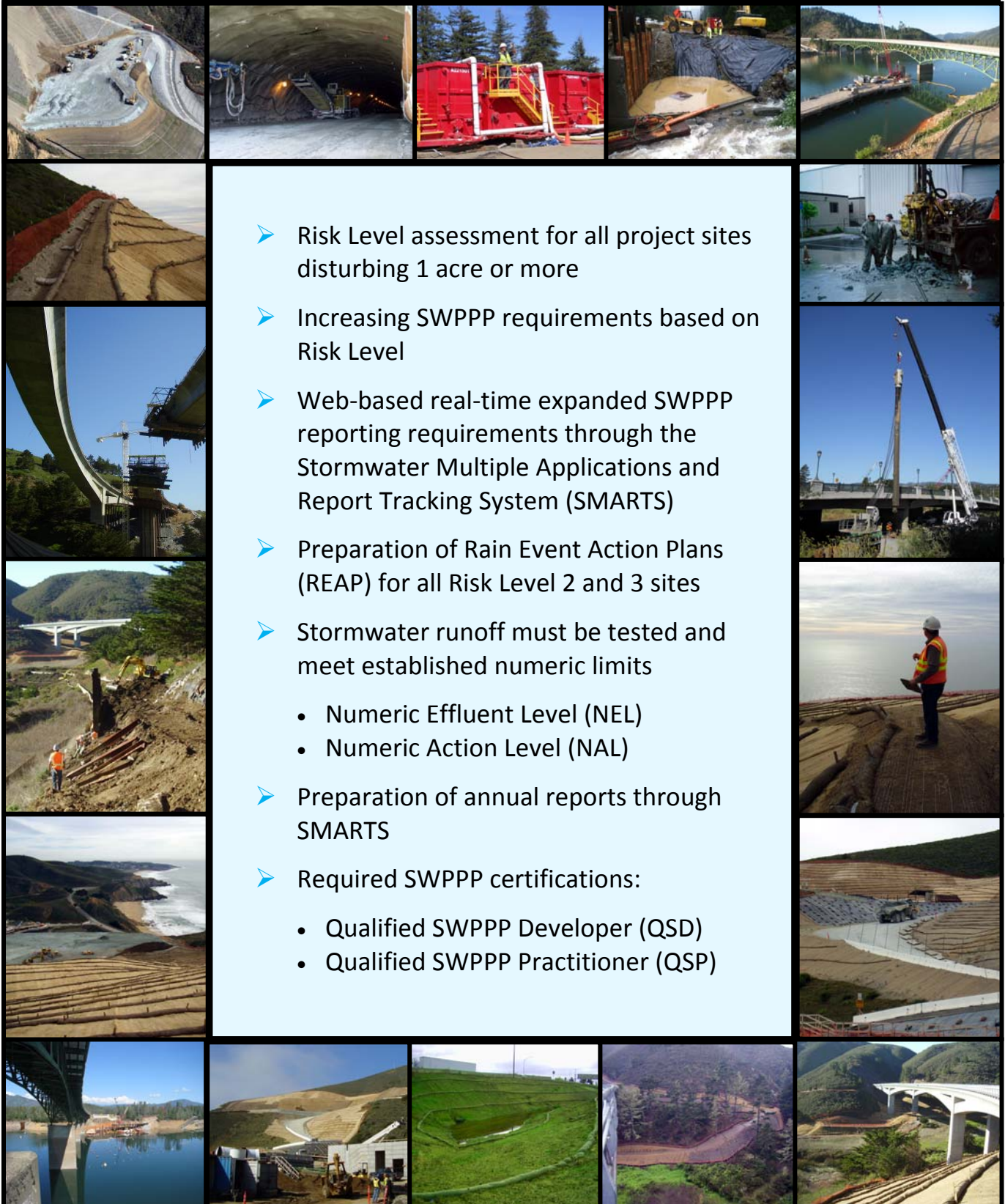


## 2009 Construction General Permit Includes Increased Requirements



- Risk Level assessment for all project sites disturbing 1 acre or more
- Increasing SWPPP requirements based on Risk Level
- Web-based real-time expanded SWPPP reporting requirements through the Stormwater Multiple Applications and Report Tracking System (SMARTS)
- Preparation of Rain Event Action Plans (REAP) for all Risk Level 2 and 3 sites
- Stormwater runoff must be tested and meet established numeric limits
  - Numeric Effluent Level (NEL)
  - Numeric Action Level (NAL)
- Preparation of annual reports through SMARTS
- Required SWPPP certifications:
  - Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD)
  - Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP)

- QSP implementation, inspections and BMP evaluations
- SMART system data entry
- Submittal of Project Reporting Documents (PRDs) and data submittal for Legally Responsible Party (LRP) certification through the SMARTS system

- On-site and workshop SWPPP compliance training
- Rain Event Action Plans (REAP)
- Rain event and periodic compliance inspections
- Stormwater runoff sampling and analysis
- Receiving water sampling planning, development, and implementation
- Stormwater Effluent Numeric Action Level (NEL) and Numeric Effluent Level (NEL) guidance
