

New Industrial General Permit Requirements for Fall 2011



- Permit implementation requires businesses to have State certified :
 - Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD)
 - Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP)
- Increased facility inspection frequencies and reporting
- Increased stormwater runoff sampling, requiring specific protocols
- Numeric Action Limits (NALs) and Numeric Effluent Limits (NELs)
- Implementation of specific minimum BMPs; requires staff training
- Electronic filing of all reports must be through the Stormwater Multiple Applications and Report Tracking System (SMARTS)
